

## Assignment of first aid service professionals (events taking place in halls)

The assignment of first aid service professionals will be determined for each event based on the guidelines presented in the following table:

Trade shows and exhibitions normally fall under the risk category "moderate/calm". Conferences, conventions, works meetings, and concerts with allocated seating also fall under the risk category "moderate/calm".
Concerts with a mainly young audience normally fall under the risk category "standard".
Special cases such as announced demonstration difficult audiences, use of crowd control barriers, a large number of VIPs, or events where extensive alcohol consumption can be expected normally fall under the risk category "difficult".

\* preparation of a first aid station in a neighbouring hall

\*\* if the outdoor area is also used, the event is generally classified as difficult
